## **Hunters Coming Out of The Cold**

**SAN ANTONIO, TX.** After years of climbing and hanging from trees in sometimes blizzard conditions, many hunters are finding comfort in the new Trophy Blinds by Texas Hunter Products. They offer two sizes, a 4'x4' and huge 4'x8'. "Being fully-enclosed like you are, the blinds keep you well protected from the outdoor elements, and there's plenty of room for the kids and grandkids" says Bob Brock the company's President. "We're seeing hunters all over the country moving into our blinds because they're wanting something that protects them from the rain, snow and cold wind...they're just comfortable and affordable" he added.

For individual hunters, the 4'x4' Single Blind is an ideal set-up because you can turn and shoot out of any direction without ever having to move (especially when you're sitting in an optional Texas Hunter Shooter's Chair that features a 360-degree Silent Swivel). If you're ever going to hunt with someone or with a guide or a camera-man, you'll want to invest a little extra for the large Texas Hunter 4'x8' Double Blind which seats three adults comfortably. The double blinds are a comfortable 8-feet long and will accommodate three of the Texas Hunter Shooter's Chairs with room to spare.

All Texas Hunter blinds are available with four different height options including 18" Ground Legs or a 5-foot, 10-foot or 15-foot powder-coated steel tower. Add an additional 4 feet for calculating your eye-level in one of these top-notch shooting houses (for a 10' tower blind, you're eye level will be 14'). The interior features a tall 6' 3" headroom with plenty of room to stand and stretch. The unique Hide-A-Way window system, a Texas Hunter exclusive, conceals your silhouette while providing a full 360-degree view out of the huge window openings that are a tall 11 ½ inches by four feet wide.

The towers include large stabilizing footpads, a ladder and the best thing about them is they're packed in a long box that's about 8 inches square. Just like the towers, the blinds themselves are packed flat for economical transport. In fact, you can fit several blinds in the back of a pick-up truck, making it easy to get them to your ideal location for set-up.

Texas Hunter has taken the work out of building your own blind or spending a lot of money on one. The lifetime limited warranty, affordable price and shipping make the Texas Hunter brand an easy choice when looking for your next shooting house. All parts are marked, cut and drilled leaving you only with the final assembly on-site. They make it easy to set-up a nice, comfortable product designed to provide years of enjoyment with family and friends.
